### Walk Saint Clair's upcoming walks are:

Wednesday, May 17th – Tree-mendous Tree Trek – led by Porcupine Pat begins at 6:30 pm at the Historical Society. Spring is beautiful in Saint Clair and a number of trees will be in bloom. This is a two-mile easy walk to enjoy the many varieties of trees in our community.

Saturday, May 27th – Southside Scramble – led by Deb Davis – begins at 10:00 am at Admiral Boone Park. Our Spring venture will take us through town and down through the industrial park and back. Be prepared for an almost 3-mile scramble

Saturday, June 3rd – Walk Around Town – led by Deb Davis begins at 10:30 am at Admiral Boone Park. We'll take an over 2 mile walk "around" the town.

Wednesday, June 14th – Woodland Terrace Hike – led by Deb Davis – begins at 6:30 pm at the Historical Society. The hike features a slow jaunt half-way up the Gun Club Hill and turning left to the Woodland Terrace Development. We'll stop and visit at Judy's backyard wild life habitat certified by the Natural Wild Life Federation. The site provides four basic habitat elements needed for wild life to thrive: food, water, cover and a place to raise young. We'll then venture through the development and around the cul-de-sac. All walks are open to the public and will be held rain or shine. In the event of severe weather (thunderstorms, etc.) we will reschedule.
